Buddhist Philosophy introduces the philosophy of Nagarjuna, the Madhyamaka school of philosophy, the Svatantrikas and Prasangikas, the Yogacara school of philosophy, Asanga and Vasubandhu. Buddhist Tantra discusses the historical emergence of Tantric Buddhism in the sixth century, Tantra as a pan-Indian (Buddhist and Hindu) phenomenon, the Vajrayana, the Mantrayana, wrathful buddhas, and the story of Maitregupta, The Theory and Practice of the Mandala discusses the mandala as a meditational device, the Buddha Akshobhya, the mandala as a symbol for the world, the chakras, the three-dimensional mandala at the Kumbum in Gyantse, Tibet, and use of mandala in the Tibetan Book of the Dead. The First Diffusion of the Dharma in Tibet reviews the destruction of Buddhist monasteries in India, and the introduction of Buddhism to Tibet during the seventh century. It presents a line of Tibetan kings who protected and fostered the growth of Buddhism in Tibet, the founding of the first Tibetan monastery, the great teacher Padmasambhava, and the Bon tradition.
