In the *Gandavyuha Sutra* (Chapter 39 of the *Avatamsaka Sutra*), Sudhana the Youth travels extensively in his search for *anuttara-samyak-sambodhi*, supreme perfect enlightenment, and he meets with 52 dharma teachers. The ancient Indonesian monument of Borobodur includes 460 reliefs depicting the entire sequence of his travels. While many of these have been badly eroded over time, they nevertheless constitute an artistic tour-de-force – some of the finest carvings available from ancient Indonesia.

If you are a tourist visiting Borobodur today, you would be given roughly one hour to view the entire monument. These documentary videos by Walid Haddad give you a much more relaxed tour – it's somewhat of a meditative experience. The videos are each approximately one hour in length, and “are a remarkable feat of dedicated story-telling” – per the summary on dharma documentaries.net. There is one notable difference between the *Gandavyuha Sutra* and the reliefs at Borobodur: at Borobodur, Sudhana the Youth is depicted as having a “retinue” of servants who travel with him – something he is missing in the Sutra itself. This was probably poetic license on the part of the aristocrats who commissioned the friezes.
